Namal college is the first step in the journey towards realizing Imran Khan's dream of creating a knowledge city in the midst of the vast wilderness of Rikhi (District: Mianwali – one of the poorest parts of the country). Namal college was established in 2008 and is now expanding; this is a result of our enduring commitment and tireless dedication. However, this incredible venture would not have been possible without the constant support of the people of Pakistan.







PROJECT UPDATES

Namal college's two storey building as it stands today covers an area of 66,000 square feet. It houses computer, electronic and robotic labs. It also contains spacious lecture rooms with state of the art facilities. To ensure the highest standards and quality of construction we at Namal employ a team of reputable consultants, electrical and public health engineers.

Our team of engineers works to keep the existing building safe from wear and tear by routinely performing building maintenance tasks and renovations as and when necessary. We are pleased to inform you that the

renovation work at the college cafeteria and kitchen has been completed and both are fully operational.

As the next step towards creating a knowledge city we plan to construct a central library and an engineering school. For this purpose Mr. Pervaiz Chaudhry & family have made a generous donation of around US \$200,000. We have also hired a team of the top architects in the country who are currently working on the architectural designs; the construction of the library building is expected to begin shortly.



ACADEMIC UPDATES

An institution's faculty is a reflection of its standards. Namal college has 7 full time PHDs amongst other qualified faculty; this is an exceptional accomplishment for an institution of this size and age in Pakistan.

Since its inception, Namal college has had an overwhelming number of applications for admissions. Each year the number of applicants surpasses previous year's figure. This year we received 1800 online applications for only 80 seats which is double from last year's applications.

Currently, we have students from 40 cities of Pakistan, transforming Namal College into a diverse cultural hub.

To synergize the efforts teachers put in, it is very important to provide state of the art labs and equipment to the students. A modern robotics lab has been established at the College, where students have outperformed their senior peers in other institutions. Recently, 7 teams from Namal college participated in the "All Pakistan Robotics competition: RoboSprint," held at CASE, Islamabad. There were a total of 32 teams participating and students from Namal College were awarded 2nd and 3rd positions in the competition.

In addition, to playing their part at the time of any emergency, these students have established a campus-wide network of blood donors which provides urgent blood support to the hospitals of Mianwali and Talagang.
